

## Oakland Pool 2020 Rules, Regulations, and Restrictions Hours M-F 1-8 Sat & Sun 1-6

- 1. Parents must accompany or have paperwork completed prior to first visit to the pool.
- 2. Swimmers will have their temperatures taken and asked screening questions
  - a. Before entering the pool every day.
- 3. Only 75 people will be allowed in the pool at a time. Understand that if your
  - a. Swimmer comes to the pool and there are 75 people they may be asked to come back at a later time, also if your swimmer has been there for  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours and others are waiting to enter the pool your child may be asked to leave.
- 4. At this time, we will not be doing sign up for time slots but if needed we will put this in place.
- 5. The break times will be 30 minutes long this year so that staff will have time to disinfect.
- 6. Swimmers will be **required** to shower with soap before entering the pool.
- 7. Swimmers must stay 6 feet apart in and outside the pool.
- 8. Swimmers must stand 6 feet apart while in line for the diving board and slide.
- 9. Toys and Noodles will not be available at the pool. Swimmers may bring a limited amount of their own pool toys for themselves and not to be shared with others.
- 10. Lifeguards will be on duty during rest breaks to see that social distancing is being followed.
- 11. Swimmers will receive one warning about the new rules.
  - If they Continue to not follow the rules, they will be asked to sit on the bench for 5 minutes. If they continue to not follow the rules after that, they will be asked to leave and parents **will** be contacted.
- 12. If you or your child becomes sick, please do not come to the pool.
- 13. If you or your child becomes sick after being at the pool, the City of Oakland and the Oakland Pool are not at fault. Please inform the City Office if this **occurs**.
- 14. Swimmers and all other attendees using the Oakland Pool acknowledge doing so carries with it certain risks of injury or harm, including, but not necessarily limited to, the contraction of certain illnesses, including COVID-19. By executing this document and using the Oakland Pool facility in any way, you voluntarily assume these risks and agree and covenant not to sue the City of Oakland or its agents and staff for any such injury, harm, or illness, and you agree to hold the City and its agents and staff harmless from any liability related thereto.

You must inform your child/children of these rules before they can begin swimming. Please print or detach the last page, sign and return to the Oakland Pool.
